Word Web Lesson

Objective: To create a word web in AW Draw

Directions:

Launch AW in Dock

Part 1: Setting up the page (Teacher can do this and save it as a template in the community folder for the younger students.)

- Choose Draw - in starting points paper w/ green triangle or File New - Draw
- Window menu - choose page view to see the whole page including the margin area
- Margins are uneven in Draw - change the format - Format - Document = Type 0.5 in Top, Bottom, Left, and Right - Click OK

Part 2:

1. Shrink page down to 66.7 or 67%
2. Text Box - Click and drag box. Write in name.
3. Click circle tool - Draw out circle in center of paper.
4. Text Box - Click and drag box. Write in word web topic.
5. Draw 4 lines coming off of circle.
6. Text Box - Click and drag box. Write an idea for each line.

Part 3: Spice up the web!

- Make lines have an arrow at the end.
- Instead of the line tool use the Irregular Polygon to draw out a line with a rectangle box at the end.
- Have students add a clipping to their document
 - ◇ Click Arrow Pointer
 - ◇ File - Show Clippings
 - ◇ Search Tab - type in noun to search for, hit return key or the search button
 - ◇ Double click on picture you want to place on the document.
 - ◇ Use the handles to resize.
 - ◇ Click on image and drag to where the image needs to be placed.
